Spartanburg Water Hosting Educational Paddle Tours On Lake Blalock

On Saturday, April 30, 2011 and Saturday, June 4, 2011, Spartanburg Water will be hosting two educational paddle tours on Lake Blalock. The tours will take kayakers and canoeists on a scenic paddle of Lake Blalock, where participants will learn about the history of Lake Blalock and Spartanburg Water’s water quality, watershed awareness and wildlife habitat protection programs. Participants are required to bring or reserve a kayak or canoe. For participants who bring their own kayak or canoe, participation is only \$15 and covers the cost of an annual non-powered boating permit for both Lake Blalock and Lake Bowen. For participants needing to reserve a watercraft, a limited number of kayaks and canoes are available. See the chart below for fee information. Participants participating in the April 30 tour must register by Thursday, April 28. Participants participating in the June 4 tour must register by Thursday, June 2. Tours are open to kayakers and canoeists of all ages and/or abilities. Paddlers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
