Spartanburg Water Announces New Watershed Sign Project in Spartanburg County

Spartanburg Water has announced a new watershed sign project in Spartanburg County. A watershed is the geographic drainage area where all water flows over or under the land on its way to a common point, such as a stream, river, lake, or ocean. The primary function of a watershed is to capture, store, and release water. Watershed signs will be placed throughout upper Spartanburg County along the boundaries of the North Pacolet, South Pacolet, and Pacolet River watersheds. The purpose of the signs is to increase public awareness about the importance of watersheds and to encourage good stewardship of Spartanburg County's waterways. The watershed signs will highlight major watersheds in the area and will display the message "Please Help Keep It Clean."
