Recent Rains Remove Need for Voluntary Water Restrictions

As a result of recent rainfall, Spartanburg Water officials are pleased to report that the reservoirs are full and the flow levels of the streams that feed its reservoirs are returning to more normal levels.

The voluntary water restrictions are being lifted effective immediately. However, it is important to remember that the area is still in moderate drought status. Customers are encouraged to continue wise use of water. Conservation of our valuable resource is important, even under normal conditions.

Spartanburg Water would like to thank its customers for their cooperation with the voluntary restrictions, which resulted in the system meeting its goal of ensuring an adequate water supply for customers during extreme drought.

Conditions will continue to be evaluated on a regular basis as the drought continues.
