Chesnee Collection System Condition Assessment and System Rehabilitation Project Professional Services for Condition Assessment and Rehabilitation Recommendations Plan

The Spartanburg Sanitary Sewer District received funding for this project from the South Carolina Infrastructure Investment Program (SCIIP). This federally funded Community Impact Grant will be administered by the South Carolina Rural Infrastructure Authority (RIA) using State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds received through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). The District is seeking a qualified firm for the Chesnee Collection System Condition Assessment and System Rehabilitation Project.
