Lake Bowen and Lake Blalock Parks Closed September 30 and October 1

SPARTANBURG – Due to the anticipated rainfall and wind that will impact the Spartanburg County area over the next two days, Lake Bowen and Lake Blalock parks and boat landings will be closed tomorrow, Friday, September 30, and Saturday, October 1.

Those with personal watercraft and marine structures around both reservoirs should refrain from going out on the water, due to potentially hazardous conditions. Watercraft should also be properly secured in order to protect them from elevated lake levels caused by excessive rain.
