Water main break prompts boil water advisory for some Spartanburg Water customers

SPARTANBURG – On Monday, June 23, Spartanburg Water System (SWS) experienced a water main break after an accident caused by a contractor working in the area. This has caused some customers to experience an interruption of service or low water pressure.

The affected water main is being repaired as quickly as possible. Once repaired, the affected area will be thoroughly flushed and tested to assure that no contamination has occurred.

There has been no confirmed contamination of the water system in this area. However, as a precautionary measure until test results can be reviewed, customers are advised to boil water intended for drinking or cooking vigorously for at least one (1) full minute prior to use. Also, any ice made from water that has not been boiled should not be used for drinking purposes.

This advisory will remain in effect until further notice.

We apologize for any inconvenience and are working as quickly as possible to resolve the issue, at which time we will notify our customers.
