Spartanburg Water to Continue First Phase of Otis Boulevard Waterline Project

The replacement of waterline from Palmetto Street to Connecticut Street will enter final stages

SPARTANBURG – In an effort to expedite the completion of the first phase of the Otis Blvd. waterline replacement project, between Palmetto St. and Connecticut St., Spartanburg Water will move forward with the final stages of this phase next week.

Beginning Monday, December 5, crews will start working to test and place the newly laid waterlines into service. The completion of this final stage of phase one is estimated to be January 2023.

The entire Otis Blvd. waterline replacement project will require three phases, and will replace aging waterlines in an effort to reduce instances of line breaks and disruptions to service to those living in this area of the Converse Heights neighborhood.
