Spartanburg Water Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Wins District Award for Excellence

Jimmy Vess receives honor as Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator of the Year

SPARTANBURG – Spartanburg Water's Jimmy Vess was awarded the Blue Ridge Foothills District Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator of the Year for 2022 at an awards banquet held on January 19.

This award is presented annually to a wastewater treatment plant operator for excellence achieved in the direct operation of a wastewater system in South Carolina. Jimmy Vess is an operator for the A. Manning Lynch, Lower North Tyger and South Tyger River Wastewater Treatment Facilities. Vess retired from Spartanburg Water in 2021 but decided to come back to the team in 2022 as a full-time employee.

"Not only did he return, he also gained a level in certification after retirement, talk about initiative," said Wastewater Treatment Superintendent, Lance Johnson. "We are grateful that Jimmy Vess was awarded for his dedication and hard work during his long career with Spartanburg Water. He is an integral part of our wastewater team."

The Blue Ridge Foothills District is one of 10 regional districts of the Water Environment Association of South Carolina (WEASC). The district includes Spartanburg, Greenville, Pickens, Oconee and Anderson counties. Annually, members are selected for outstanding service in categories as defined by the WEASC. These individuals are now eligible to receive awards from the corresponding state organization in March.
